

## Sunnats for the day of Eid-ul-Adhã

- 1) To wake up early
- 2) To clean the teeth with a Miswãk
- 3) To have a masnoon bath
- 4) To dress in one's best clothes
- 5) To apply Itr (fragrance)
- 6) To go early for Eid Salãh
- 7) To walk to Eid Salãh
- 8) To use different routes to and from the place of Eid Salah

9) To recite the following takbeer aloud whilst going for Eid Salāh:

اَللَّهُ اَكْبَرُ اَللَّهُ اَكْبَرُ لَا اِللَّهُ اللَّهُ اللَّهُ

وَاللَّهُ آكْبَرُ اَللَّهُ آكْبَرُ وَلِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ

Allāhu akbar, Allāhu akbar, La ilāha illallāhu wallāhu akbar, Allāhu akbar wa lillāhil hamd

10) To eat the Qurbani meat of one's own offering

## Greeting for the day of Eid

On Eid day, the Sahābah الله عند used to greet one another by saying: تَقَبَّلَ الله مِنَّا وَمِنْكُمْ

Transliteration: Taqabballāhu minnā wa minkum Translation: May Allāh accept (the good deeds) from us and you. (Fath-ul-Bāri)
