

Sunnats for the day of Eid-ul-Adhā

- 1) To wake up early
- 2) To clean the teeth with a Miswāk
- 3) To have a masnoon bath
- 4) To dress in one's best clothes
- 5) To apply Itr (fragrance)
- 6) To go early for Eid Salāh
- 7) To walk to Eid Salāh
- 8) To use different routes to and from the place of Eid Salāh

- 9) To recite the following takbeer aloud whilst going for Eid Salāh:

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ

وَاللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ وَلِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ

Allāhu akbar, Allāhu akbar,
 La ilāha illallāhu wallāhu
 akbar, Allāhu akbar wa
 lillāhil hamd

- 10) To eat the Qurbāni meat of one's own offering

Greeting for the day of Eid

On Eid day, the Sahābah رضي الله عنهم used to greet one another by saying: **تَقَبَّلَ اللَّهُ مِنَّا وَمِنْكُمْ**

Transliteration: Taqabballāhu minnā wa minkum

Translation: May Allāh accept (the good deeds) from us and you. (Fath-ul-Bāri)
