

Du'ā On The Occasion Of Hot Weather

On an extremely hot day, if a person
recites the following du'ā:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ ، مَا أَشَدَّ حَرَّ هَذَا الْيَوْمِ ،
اللَّهُمَّ أَجِرْنِي مِنْ حَرِّ جَهَنَّمَ

Transliteration: Lā ilāha illallāhu, mā ashadda harra
hādhal yawm, allāhumma ajirni min harri jahannam

Translation: There is no diety except Allāh. How hot is this
day! Oh Allāh, Protect me from the heat of Jahannam.

Allāh, the Mighty and Exalted, says to Jahannam,
“Indeed one of my servants has asked me for protection
from your heat. Bear witness that I have protected him.”
(‘Amalul-Yawmi Wal-Laylah)
