VIRTUES OF AL-MASJID AL-AQSÃ

First Qiblah

Al-Maşjid Al-Aqsã was the first Qiblah until Allãh Ta'ãlã commanded the Prophet stoface the Ka'bah.

Barã anarrates, "We prayed with the Prophet facing Baytul-Maqdis for 16 or 17 months. Thereafter, Alläh Ta'älä commanded him to face the Ka'bah." (Bukhāri)



Second Masjid in History

Al-Maşjid Al-Aqsã - which is situated in the city of Jerusalem in Palestine - is the second Maşjid to be built on this earth.

Abu-Dharr reported that he asked the Prophet, "O Messenger of Alläh, which Masjid was built first on earth?" The Prophet replied, "Al-Masjid Al-Haram." I asked again, "Then which next?" The Prophet replied, "Al-Masjid Al-Aqsa." I further asked, "How much time was there in between them being built?" The Prophet replied, "40 years." (Bukhari and Muslim)

Blessed Land

Alläh Ta'älä mentions in the Qur'än, "Glorious is He Who made his servant travel by night from Al-Maşjid Al-Haräm to Al-Maşjid Al-Aqsä whose surroundings We have blessed, so that we let him see some of Our signs. Surely, He is the All-Hearing, the All-Seeing." (Surah Isrä, Ayat 1)

The land surrounding Al-Maşjid Al-Aqsã is the blessed land of As-Shãm (the Greater Syria) which included the countries of Jordan, Syria, Cyprus, Palestine and Lebanon.

Other Virtues

Alläh Ta'älä said, "O Shäm! You are the best of my lands and I shall inhabit you with the chosen ones among My servants."

(At-Tabräni)

The angels of Alläh Ta'älä have spread their wings over this land. (Tirmidhi)

Nabi informed the Sahābah that Shām is the land where everyone will be brought together and brought back to life. From there they will be taken to the hereafter. (Abu Dāwood)

There is not an inch in A1-Quds where a prophet has not prayed or an Angel has not stood. (Tirmidhi)
