DU'Ã AT THE TIME OF TA'ZIYAH

Upon the demise of a person, it is recommended to recite the following du'ã to the family members and close associates:

Transliteration: A'dhamallāhu ajraka, wa ahsana 'azā'aka, wa ghafara li mayyitika.

Translation: May Allãh increase your reward, grant you heartfelt consolation and forgive your deceased.



DU'Ã AT THE TIME OF TA'ZIYAH

When the grandson of Nabi passed away, he recited this du'ā to his daughter:

Transliteration: Inna lillāhi mā akhadha wa lahū mā a'tā, wa kullun 'indahū bi ajalim-musammā, faltasbir wal tahtasib.

Translation: Verily, whatever Allāh takes is his and whatever he gives is his. And everything has an appointed time. So be patient and seek rewards. (Bukhāri)
