

DU'Ā AT THE TIME OF TA'ZIYAH

Upon the demise of a person, it is recommended to recite the following du'ā to the family members and close associates:

أَعْظَمَ اللَّهُ أَجْرَكَ وَأَحْسَنَ
عَزَائِكَ وَغَفَرَ لِمَيِّتِكَ

Transliteration: A'dhamallāhu ajraka, wa ahsana 'azā'aka, wa ghafara li mayyitika.

Translation: May Allāh increase your reward, grant you heartfelt consolation and forgive your deceased.

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When the grandson of Nabi ﷺ passed away, he recited this du'ā to his daughter:

إِنَّ لِلَّهِ مَا أَخَذَ وَلَهُ مَا أُعْطِيَ
وَكُلُّ عِنْدَهُ بِأَجَلٍ مُّسَمًّى
فَلْتَصْبِرْ وَلْتَحْتَسِبْ

Transliteration: Inna lillāhi mā akhadha wa lahū mā a'tā, wa kullun 'indahū bi ajalim-musammā, faltasbir wal tahtasib.

Translation: Verily, whatever Allāh takes is his and whatever he gives is his. And everything has an appointed time. So be patient and seek rewards. (Bukhāri)
