## THE DU'Ã OF HADHRAT ANAS WINTUE AND TRANSLATION

Virtue: Hadhrat Anas radhiallāhu anhu has mentioned that Nabi staught him this du'ā through which one can safeguard himself from every accursed shaytān and obstinate oppressor. One should aim to recite this du'ā three times every morning and three times every evening.

Translation: (I seek blessings) in the name of Allāh upon myself and my Deen. (I seek blessings) in the name of Allāh upon that which my mighty and majestic lord has given me. (I seek blessings) in the name of Allāh upon my family and my wealth. Allāh is the greatest, Allāh is my lord. Allāh is the greatest, Allāh is my lord. Save me (Oh Allāh) from every accursed shaytān and from every obstinate oppressor. Indeed, my guardian is Allāh who revealed the Qur'ān and He protects the pious people. Thus, if they (the refusers) turn away, then say that Allāh is sufficient for me, there is no diety except Him. Only in Him do I place my trust and He is the lord of the magnificent throne. (Ad-Du'ā Lit-Tabrāni)
