

DU'Ā ON THE OCCASION OF HOT WEATHER

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ،

مَا أَشَدَّ حَرَّ هَذَا الْيَوْمِ،

اللَّهُمَّ أَجِرْنِي مِنْ حَرِّ جَهَنَّمَ

*Transliteration: Lā ilāha illallāhu, mā ashadda harra
hādhal yawm, allāhumma ajirni min harri jahannam*

*Translation: There is no diety except Allāh. How hot is
this day! Oh Allāh, Protect me from the heat of Jahannam.*

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*On an extremely hot day, if a person
recites the following du'ā:*

*Lā ilāha illallāhu, mā ashadda harra
hādhal yawm, allāhumma ajirni min
harri jahannam*

*Allāh, the Mighty and Exalted, says to
Jahannam, “Indeed one of my servants has
asked me for protection from your heat.
Bear witness that I have protected him.”*
